Many battles loomed over the existence of PEG television. DATV staff, board, and community members sent letters supporting the CAP Act to Cong. Mike Turner's Office. The CAP Act seeks to reverse damage caused to access centers by statewide franchising.

Additionally, DATV members addressed city commissioners during their regular meetings thanking them for their past support. Members and producers were very appreciative to the commission and asked for their continued support as DATV's current contract ends January 31, 2013.

New partnerships were formed while old partnerships were renewed. DATV and FilmDayton partnered with hopes that members from each will benefit from the other's services. Also, the Dayton Job Corp. provided a computer tech to assist with building the 8-new editing computers. And DATV again partnered with WKEF-TV for the Feast of Giving. This annual community event brings people together to celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday season.

On the technology front. Many technological advances were seen by DATV members in 2011 with the additional of new robotic studio cameras, new editing computers, and the addition of new Mac computers. Also, DATV launched its ftp site affording producers the opportunity to submit programs to via the internet. As always, DATV staff strives to make available to its members the latest technological advancements.

In 2013, DATV will be celebrating 35 years of service to the Dayton community. We anticipate events throughout the year highlighting this milestone including the introduction of a new DATV logo. With these exciting developments we would be remiss if we weren't reminded of the challenges we face in 2012 and looking forward to 2013. As I frequently mention, DATV's strengths lie in the efforts of its members and the value they bring to the community. We must always be reminded the role DATV plays in the cultural development of our great city and the importance it brings in connecting citizens throughout the region.

There are 3 full size DV and 8 mini DV cameras available for member use. In addition to the 4 edit suites with both tape-to-tape editing and AVID nonlinear systems, DATV has 4 stand alone AVID edit systems and a studio control room.
