DATV celebrated 35 years of service to Dayton in 2013, providing citizens a venue for freedom of expression. 35 years is a major milestone in anyone's book and only made possible through the support of Dayton's city leaders and dedicated members.

2013 also brought DATV the beginning of a new 10 year contract with the city of Dayton that continued our mission of providing citizens with the best in community television training and equipment. Speaking of equipment, a plethora of new gear arrived in 2013 in the form of 10, new HD field cameras, GoPro cameras, new light kits, computer upgrades, wireless studio mics, TriCaster studio switcher upgrade, and new Adobe Premiere Elements editing software. ## **DATV Overview**





DATV is a member of the Alliance For Community Media. The Alliance if a national advocacy and networking organization comprised of Public, Educational and Government access channels.

#### Learn, Create, Communicate

DATV provides the training, equipment and facilities for local residents to create their very own non-commercial cable TV programs. The programs created cover a wide variety of topics.

The programs can then be seen on DATV, Time Warner Cable channel 5 or Dayton Spiritual Television channel 992.

Memberships start at \$50 per year and include everything you need to start producing. In addition to airing programs on cable TV many producers and nonprofit organizations put the program on their websites for on demand viewing.

DATV's first studio was located in one room in the basement of Roberts Hall at the United Theological Seminary off of Salem Avenue in Dayton.
