OUR MISSION

DATV is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization that, since 1978, has given Dayton the “Freedom to Communicate.”

Our mission is to serve as a community forum that empowers all citizens to learn, create, and express their ideas through electronic media. As the original form of social media, DATV provides the training, equipment, and facilities for local residents to create their very own non-commercial local cable TV programs.

DATV operates two cable access channels in the City of Dayton, Ohio. DATV is a public access channel seen on Spectrum channel 5 in Dayton, Riverside and Butler Twp, and on channel 6 or 23 in the northern suburbs. Dayton Spiritual Television is a religious access channel seen regionally on Spectrum Ch. 992.

Greetings Good People!

How do I begin to reflect on 2019? It was a year where we were tested—again and again and again and yet again. Aging municipal infrastructure failed early in the year causing DATV and parts of Old North Dayton to be without potable water for days. We carted water in gallon jugs and personal water bottles for a week. No one went thirsty, toilets flushed, hands were washed. #WaterFlowingUnderground

Outside forces tested our commitment to defending the First Amendment Free Speech & Assembly clause of the US Constitution when the Ku Klux Klan came to town. DATV, choosing not to fan the flames of hatred, did not broadcast the rally, and instead supported our member producers who recorded and stood witness against that hate in counter rallies being staged all over Dayton. #UnitedAgainstHate

Then a mighty wind scoured our neighborhoods and many of our extended DATV family had their lives, their homes, their security and sense of place irrevocably destroyed. The 25+ tornadoes that ripped through the Miami Valley on Memorial Day Holiday left a trail of destruction unlike anything we had ever collectively seen before. DATV member producers responded by recording extraordinary acts of kindness and generosity and shared these videos of hope with the greater Dayton community. DATV continued to support tornado survivors as a Media Sponsor for The Greater Dayton Disaster Relief Fund Benefit Concert, where over \$5,000 was raised for the clean-up effort. #DaytonStrong

In August, violence and tragedy struck down eight innocents and wounded eighteen more in The Oregon District, our City’s playground, and Dayton joined the cohort of American cities where mass shootings have occurred. In the days and weeks that followed, DATV producers recorded memorial services and rallies demonstrating a spirit of solidarity with the fallen and the resolve to document the grit and determination of Daytonians to heal each other and rise up stronger. #DoSomething

Throughout this past year, DATV was present. We were in the moment documenting the stories of resilience and vulnerability, capturing the essence of the Gem City. DATV Staff and Member Producers stood witness for the dead and the lost and we celebrated the survivors and the fighters. We are not the same as we were a year ago, we’re deeper, we’re fiercer, we’re feistier. We are #DATVStrong.

3. Audio

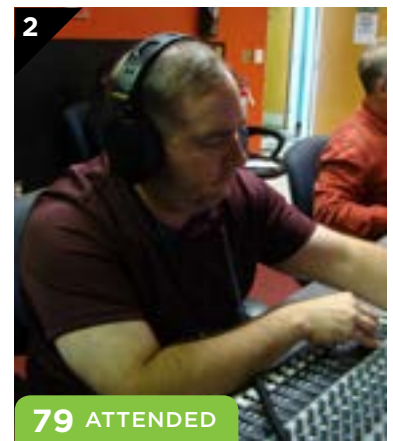
Attendees learn proper microphone techniques, sound mixing, and sound board operation.

7. Robotic Camera

Camera control, shot framing, automated presets are offered to members during this workshop.

8. Directing

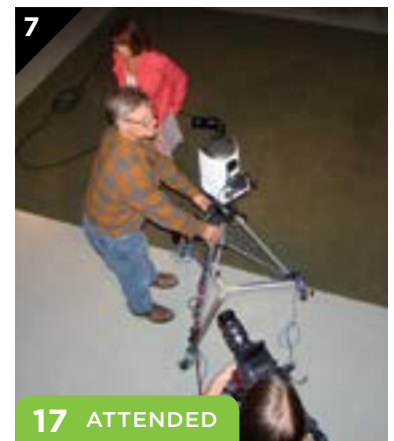
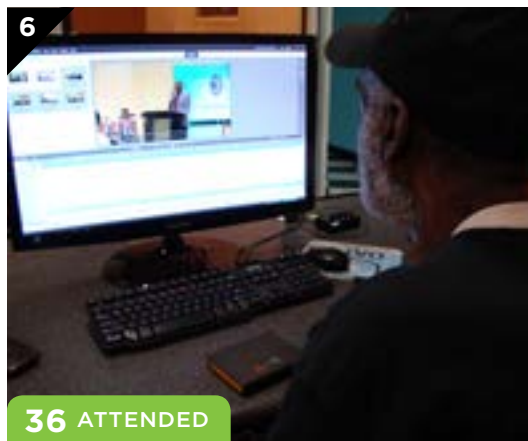
Attendees learn how to communicate with a crew during a studio program. We also include conversations on shot selection, graphics integration, audio mixing, and much more.

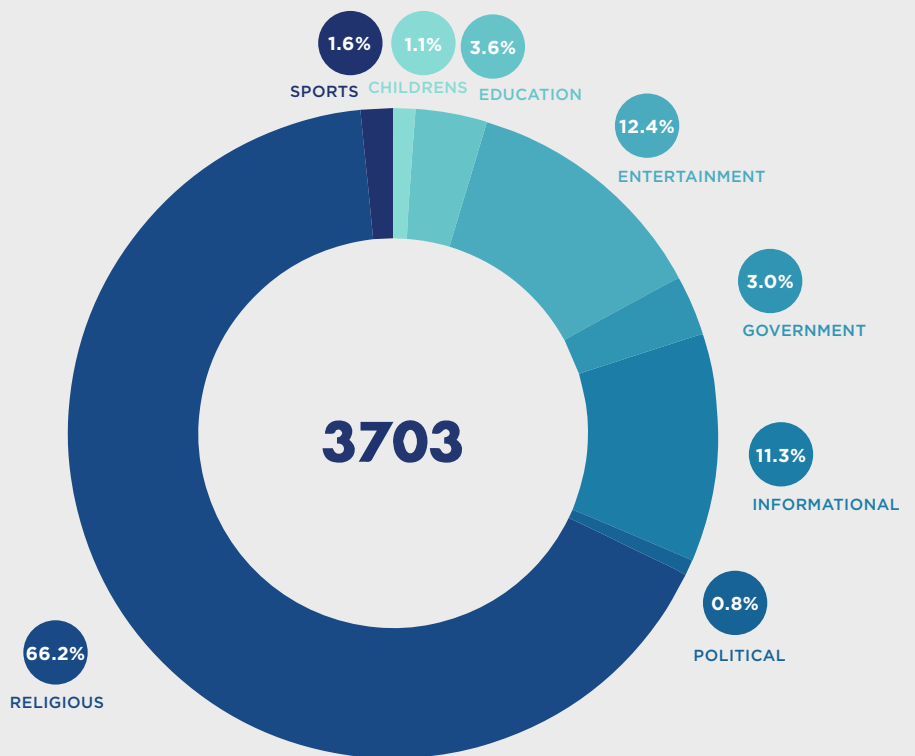

Andrew is the producer and host of Gem City Tonight and a consistent help to all those creating content at DATV.

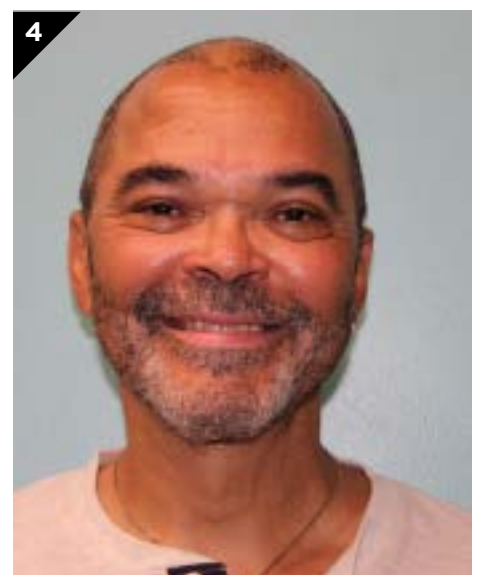


2. Cheryl Thomas, Perseverance Award

UPGRADES

During 2019 communicating with your neighbors became more important than ever.

The internet and social media are now the technology that drives communication. As a result, we are witnessing technological advancements at a pace never seen before; and with that, the public's desire for these advancements pushes the technologies further and faster. As an organization, we continue to stay on top of these ever changing needs and to make this technology available to the citizens in hopes they continue to use their voices to change their community.



DATV continues to strive for excellence by providing the very highest quality equipment and facilities for its members.

Consistent upgrades offer new technology and new opportunities to our members and our community.

FACILITY UPGRADES

A major upgrade to DATV was the redesign of Master Control. Master Control houses the equipment that’s responsible for the airing and streaming of community producer programs.

This room is the heart of DATV’s facility and was upgraded to Tightrope Media Systems Cablecast Flex4 server for playback and installed 2-Carousel bulletin board messaging systems.

Most of the programs played from this room were produced in high definition, but due to restrictions by the cable company, we converted to standard definition to air over DATV’s channels.

UPGRADED EDITING SOFTWARE

DATV also updated it’s editing software in 2019 from Premiere Elements 2014 to Premiere Elements 2019 and Photoshop Elements 2019. It had been a few years between upgrades since there were issues with a previous upgrade and how it handled audio. In 2019 however, Adobe addressed this issue which gave DATV the opportunity to upgrade.



NEW EDITING COMPUTERS

Another major upgrade was made to DATV’s editing computers. Retired and re-purposed were the old core i7 computers with 32gb of RAM. The new computers were built with heavy duty core i9 processors, 64gb of RAM, 11gb graphics cards, and other amenities. These new builds were welcome upgrades for the members since they retired computers built 6 to 7 years ago.

ENTRYWAY DOOR SYSTEM

A major facility upgrade came later in 2019 and in the form of a new entryway door system. It is now much easier for those with special needs to use DATV’s facilities with the upgraded push panel door assist system. “We are so grateful we were able to upgrade our old pull system to this new, and much easier to use system push system”, said DATV Operations Manager, Steve Ross.



COMMUNITY OUTREACH

As a 501(c)(3), DATV knows how tight the budget can be when it comes to marketing and promotional costs. That's why we continued to host several Non Profit Days throughout 2019. We opened up our studio to Dayton's NPO community so they could record a 3-5 minute video to promote the amazing work they do.

And it still didn't cost them a penny.

DATV knows that non profit development and marketing departments don't always have the resources to do promotional video. And they live on the internet—they live on social media—which means video. And DATV is all about the VIDEO! We want our NPO friends to know that DATV can help. We can be an extension to their Development efforts, their Marketing Plans, their Communications Strategies.
